

Nutmeg Labelling Module

The Nutmeg program is compliant with the Natasha's Law, the new law which was introduced as of the 1st October 2021.

The features for the labelling feature within the Nutmeg program are listed below:

- 1. Printing recipes as labels that have been created in the recipe analysis or imported into the Nutmeg program as a manufactured product.
- 2. Labels can be sent via PDF format.
- 3. Ability to print straight from the Nutmeg program.
- 4. Nastasha's Law compliant for the October 2021
- 5. Having the option to print multiple labels on one page.
- 6. Labels can be printed with a conventional printer.
- 7. Label information updated in real time when an ingredient/s or allergen information changes within a recipe.
- 8. Adding compound ingredients from suppliers
- 9. Adding three different prices to the labels
- 10. Adding the used by date to the label
- 11. Adding additional free text to the label as well
- 12. Adding a logo to the label
- 13. Recipes notes for the recipe analysis within the Nutrition part of the Nutmeg program.
- 14. Hints wording can be brought over into the labelling feature from the Nutritional side of the program
- 15. Different sizes of labels can be printed to a A4 printer
- 16. A preview of the label can be seen throughout all the stages of the developing label and can be updated in real time through each of the stages
- 17. The program has the option to increase the text size from 0.9mm to 1.2mm if the covering package is over 80sq cm, this option can be toggled on and off.
- 18. Different user levels can be set up for the labelling feature, these are described at Admin and Catering staff privileges. The Catering staff only have access to the labelling feature and the admin staff have access to the entire Nutmeg program and the labelling feature.
